

Greetings to all the Faithful at Edgewood Lutheran Church!

I am Pastor Leonard Dahlgren and at the January, 2017 church council meeting I signed a contract with the church council which officially makes me the interim pastor of the congregation. I know you have had interim pastors before, so this arrangement may not seem new to you, but it is for me. How long does an interim pastor serve? My contract is for one year, but it may be renewed. Pastor Paul Kehnle served as an interim pastor here for three years and I could envision myself being here that long or longer if it is the Lord's will.

Let me tell you a little bit about myself. I was born in Chicago and grew up there having been baptized as an infant and later confirmed as a youth at Bethlehem Lutheran Church. I graduated from the University of Illinois with a degree in history. I attended what is now Trinity Lutheran Seminary in Columbus, Ohio and graduated in 1975. I have had calls to congregations Springfield, Illinois, Southgate, Michigan, Jackson, Michigan, and Kent City, Michigan. I received a doctor of ministry degree from the Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago in 1999 focusing on Christian spirituality. After 41 years of pastoral ministry I retired at the end of August last year. My wife, Cindy and I, have been married for 31 years, and we have two adult children. Rachel, the oldest, is a social worker in Chicago, and Nathan is an RN in Grand Rapids. Cindy and I bought a home in Holland, Michigan and we moved in on September 1 of last year after I retired. I jog and exercise faithfully, enjoy reading, cooking, gardening, and playing golf and tennis.

I have experienced God's love continuously over the course of my life. I grew up in a loving family, and even after my mother's death when I was an early teen, God's love came to me anew in many unexpected ways. It has been my fervent desire to respond to God's amazing love and grace by serving Him in and through his church.

These are challenging times for Christ's We live in a world that is church. becoming more secularized, and sadly, religious belief and church involvement are being marginalized. The world needs God's love revealed in Jesus Christ more than ever. Christian communities of faith have much to offer. Cindy and I have experienced the people of Edgewood to be a caring group of people dedicated to the Lord. I am honored to serve as your pastor and I look forward to serving you and working with you in proclaiming and living the love of Christ in Fruitport, the wider communities in which we live, and the world.




